

COUCH

EASY



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Overlocker
- Domestic Sewing Machine
- Fabric Scissors
- Squared plastic ruler
- · Chalk
- Dressmaking Pins
- Fabric type 1 for body
- Fabric type 2 for pockets

#### PREPARATION:

- Cut x1 of fabric for outer body
- Cut x1 of fabric for lower body

#### STED

Overlock top edge of fabric type 2 for pockets


#### STEP 2

Using an iron on a low heat, press down top edge of caddy pocket 1cm.

# STEP 3

Topstitch the top edge down at 0.8cm.

# PATTERN



## STEP 4

Lay the pocket section to the body of the remote caddy, and stay stitch the pocket panel to the bottom around the seam allowance.

# STEP 5

Using the iron once again, press the seam allowance around the edges of the full panel down 2cm. Fold the top and bottom end of the caddy down after pressing the sides. Pin the seam allowance down to the body to ensure the grain stays aligned.

### STEP 6

Turn the fabric pieces the wrong way up. Starting from the top right hand corner in a clockwise direction, sew a straight line through the seam allowance, (around 1.8cm) ensuring the grain stays true, removing pins as you sew. Take a 90 degree turn with your needle as you turn the corner, keeping the topstitch line neat. Complete all edges of caddy.

# STEP 7


From the stitched border on the topside of the pocket part of the caddy, measure 14cm increments across for the 3 pockets. Use pins to direct the topstitch lines you are about to sew.

### STEP 8

Stitch straight lines up the fabric pocket piece to create dividers, ensuring you backstitch at the top for extra support. Complete 2 rows to create three pockets.

#### STEP 9

Your remote caddy is complete and ready to join you on the couch!
