

# Conditions of Entry during COVID-19

Updated 14 April 2021



## Conditions of entry for BPC gatherings:

If you or your children are unwell, especially with flu like symptoms, you must not enter.

Isolate yourself and get tested if you have not already done so.

If you are awaiting COVID-19 test results, or are a close contact of a COVID-19 infected person, you must not enter until given the all clear by the Health Department. [For fuller information please see our Health guidelines <https://bpc.org.au/coronavirus-faqs>]

## When attending a BPC gathering:

1. To fulfill Government contact tracing requirements all those entering the building must either scan the QR code posters available at our front entrance (location code HRK DCH) or manually fill in the contact tracing record available in our foyer.
2. You must carry an approved face mask and when current regulations require a mask to be worn, wear a face mask correctly.
3. You must practise social distancing: avoid physical contact and keep 1.5m away from others wherever possible.
4. You must clean your hands with soap and water, or hand sanitiser at the start and end of any gathering, and at other times as needed.
5. You must follow the instructions of ushers and signage for each space in the building.
6. There can be no sharing of food or drink at our meetings.
7. As extensive cleaning is required after each service we ask that you leave after the service when directed to.

If a Pastor or Elder asks you to leave because of our COVID-19 safety plan, you must comply with the request.

There are limits in place for the number of people permitted on each church site and within each room, and we must keep to those limits.
