No such thing as a free lunch?

1. God’s Gracious Gift (vv. 1-10)

- A great man with a great need (v.1).
- A word of hope (v.2).
- God’s gift offered free of charge (vv.4-10, 15b-16).

Do you have the right view of God?

2. Naaman’s response to God’s gift.

- His first response – Pride that gets in the way (vv.11-12).
- His second response – Humility that leads to healing (vv.13-19)

Which way are you responding to God’s gift to you?

3. Gehazi’s response to God’s gift.

- The depths of his sin – Coveted, Lied, Stole. (vv.20-24).
- The damage from his sin – Distorted the message of God’s free grace (vv.25-27).

Are you believing/speaking the true gospel?*
