

Conditions of Entry during COVID-19

Updated 17 December 2021



Conditions of Entry for BPC gatherings:

If you or your children are unwell, especially with flu like symptoms, you must not enter.

We recommend you get a test if you have not already done so.

If you are awaiting COVID-19 test results, or have been asked to isolate, you must not enter until you have completed your isolation period. [For fuller information please see our Health Guidelines <https://bpc.org.au/coronavirus-faqs>]

When attending a BPC gathering:

1. To fulfill Government requirements all those entering the building must either scan the Vic Gov QR code posters available at our front entrance (location code HRK DCH) or manually fill in the Vic Gov sheet, available on the foyer table.
2. We also ask that all entering our building “check-in” using our Nametags system, as we are now responsible for contact tracing and notifying close contacts at our gatherings. When our Nametags system is not in use, groups/visitors may complete the BPC attendance sheet, available on the foyer table.
3. You must carry an approved face mask and when current regulations require a mask to be worn, wear a face mask correctly.
4. You must practise social distancing and keep 1.5m away from others wherever possible.
5. You must clean your hands with soap and water, or hand sanitiser at the start and end of any gathering, and at other times as needed.
6. You must follow the instructions of ushers and signage for each space in the building.

If a Pastor or Elder asks you to leave because of our COVID-19 safety plan, you must comply with the request.

When there are limits in place for the number of people permitted on each church site and within each room, we must keep to those limits.
