

How do we worship God the Holy Spirit?

Who With the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified, but do we?

Acts 4:24-27, Eph.3:14; Acts 7:59-60, 2 Cor. 12:8-9, 2 Thess. 2:16-17; 1 Cor. 1:3, Rom. 1:7, Col. 1:3, 1 Thess. 1:2 [1 Cor. 16:23, Eph. 6:18, Gal. 6:18, Phil. 4:23]; Heb. 13:20, Jude 24-25, Eph. 6:7, Rom. 16:27;

The Spirit deserves to be worshipped with the Father and the Son, because He is God, the third person of the Trinity

The Spirit is God 1 Cor. 2:10-11, Mark 3:29, Acts 5:3-4; Matt. 28:19

The Spirit is the third person of the Trinity Acts 8:29, 10:19, 13:2-4, 16:6-7; Eph. 4:30; John 14:16, 26, 15:26, 16:13-15

An eternal person John 15:26 – ‘procession’ [Romans 8:9, Galatians 4:6, Romans 8:14-15]

One in the work of salvation with the Father and the Son 1 Pet. 1:2, 2 Cor. 13:14, 1 Cor. 12:4-6; [Eph. 1:3-14, Acts 2:33, 38-39, 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14]

How do we worship the Spirit? John 4:22-24

John 16:14 “He will glorify me” [Heb. 13:15]

The better question – How do we honour the Spirit in our lives
