Rescue

1. The Seriousness of Their Salvation (vv.19-23)

A slave to all:

- To win Jews.
- To win Gentiles.
- To win the weak.

“All things to all people” so that some might be saved.

Implications:

Following Paul’s example (1 Cor 11:1)

1. *Cultivate a compassionate heart.*
2. *Make yourself known.*
3. *Be flexible and faithful.*

2. The Seriousness of My Salvation (vv.24-27)

The grief of falling away.

Running to “win the prize.”

Implications:

1. *Think humbly of yourself.*
2. *Be disciplined.*
3. *Keep your eyes on the gospel prize.*
