

## **Mark 5:21-6:6**

### **Comforting Authority**

#### **Jairus' daughter - part 1 (5:21-24)**

The desperate dependent trust (DDT) of Jairus

Jesus responds to someone of influence

#### **The bleeding woman (5:25-34)**

The desperate dependent trust (DDT) of the sick woman

Jesus responds to someone who shouldn't be there (Lev 15:19-22)

Jesus saves and restores

#### **Jairus's daughter - part 2 (5:35-43)**

Sickness becomes death which is sleep to Jesus

"Only believe" (v.36 also see John 11:25)

#### **Application:**

Jesus strong (in sickness and death)

*and* gentle (to all who turn to him)

#### **The Nazarenes fail (6:1-6)**

The Familiarity Bred Contempt (FBC) of Jesus' hometown

#### **Application:**

How will you respond to Jesus?

DDT or FBC

#### **Big Idea**

*Jesus shows that he is strong and kind in the face of sickness and death. We can be like Jairus and the woman who showed their desperate, dependent trust in Jesus and not like the Nazarenes who had contempt for Jesus when given a prime opportunity.*
