

The Cries and Conviction of Jesus

Mark 14:32-52

1. The Cries of Jesus (14:32-40)

We see Jesus as never before: distressed, troubled, sorrowful

“Abba Father” (Mark 1:11, Romans 8:15)

“All things are possible for you, take this cup from me” (Isaiah 51:17, Psalm 75:8, Jer 25:15-16)

“Not what I will but what you will” (v.36)

We see our failure in their failure

Application:

Can you see Jesus – truly like us but not?

(Hebrews 2:14-18; 4:15-17)

2. The Conviction of Jesus (14:41-52)

Cometh the hour, cometh the Son of man (v.41)

The ultimate betrayal (v.45)

They flee because Jesus won't fight (v.50, cf.v.27 and Zech 13:7)

The Scriptures must be fulfilled (Isaiah 53:7)

The obedient Son is our Saviour (Hebrews 5:7-9)

Application:

Can you trust Jesus – our champion?
