Jesus: Worth it

Context: Ordinary and Extraordinary

- Born into a righteous family (v.21-23, Gen 17:9-14, Lev 12:1-8, Exo 13,2,12)
- Born into a poor family (v.24)
- Named by the angel (v.22, 1:31, Matt 1:21)

Jesus - Worth the Wait

Meet Simeon and Anna

- Righteous, devout, prayerful (v.25, 37)
- Waiting in hope for God's messiah (v.26, 38)
- Led by the Spirit of God (v.25, 26, 27, 36)
- Jesus is the Redemption of Jerusalem (v.38)
- Jesus is the Saviour for all people (v.32; Isa 49:1-6)
- He will save them through his death for sin (Isa 53:5,6)

Jesus - Worth the Witness

- The source of conflict between people (v.34)
- The sword who reveals our hearts (v.35)
- Anna: "she began to thank God and to speak about him [Jesus] to all" (v.38)
